Bikur Cholim, Inc. is a not-for-profit community-based health services organization, established in 1981 to provide "health-related services" to Rockland County, New York. Bikur Cholim is the largest single provider of behavioral health services Rockland County. Bikur Cholim also provides a variety of support services to hospital patients and their families in the Town of Ramapo, New York.

The organization is asking The Disability Opportunity Fund to make a loan of \$500,000 to Bikur Cholim in partnership with the Leviticus Fund. The loan would be used by Bikur Cholim to acquire and renovate a mental health clinic in Monsey, New York. This acquisition would help Bikur Cholim expand their services in their community by offering a new facility that they are able to operate and use to better serve the community. Bikur Cholim is also seeking a second loan from The DOF to purchase a new building in Pomona, NY to expand services and provide outpatient mental health services to their clients.

1st Loan Summary

Amount: \$1,425,000

DOF Participation: \$500,000
